

Owen Sound Scouting 2010 Winter Campout

All registered Scouts, Venturers, and Rovers are invited to the **47th Annual Owen Sound Winter Campout** being held at **Harrison Park, Owen Sound, Ontario, January 29–31, 2010**. Rovers are welcome to come and help run some of the events.

Registration will be 7:00pm – 10:00pm Friday & 7:30am – 9:00am Saturday. All leaders in charge must immediately register their group upon arrival at the Camp. Registration fee this year is \$14.00 per camper, including leaders. Hockey Tickets will be \$7.50 this year. Registrations by mail or email will be accepted however a \$50 non-refundable payment must be received payable to “Scouts Canada” to reserve your campsite. Note: Register early as space is limited and will be available only on a first come first served basis. Anyone arriving after 10:00pm Friday evening **MUST** register by 9:00am Saturday.

Owen Sound Scouting 2010 Winter Campout: Camp Rules

1. The timetable and these rules must be shared with everyone attending this winter campout.
2. These rules, timetable, your menu, and duty roster must be printed, brought to camp, and posted in the campsite. As these items are part of pre-camps preparation and included in inspection points, none will be available on site.
3. Parking: Vehicles must be parked in designated areas. All camp supplies will be unloaded at the flagpole circle. Absolutely no vehicles or trailers beyond the flag pole circle at any time prior, during or after the camp. One leader must remain with vehicle at all times. License #'s must be left with registrars at the headquarter bldg. Vehicles must be moved to designated parking area immediately upon unloading.
4. All campsites must be identified. (signs / flags)
5. **Do not drink any water from creeks or river!** Use water from the 'garage' faucet.
6. No standing trees or saplings to be cut or scarred in the park.
7. The Park Inn (Restaurant) is **out of bounds** to **all** campers & leaders at **all times**.
8. No tent heaters of any type or description allowed in camp Any questions please contact the Camp Safety Adviser.
9. No wood will be brought into the park. Wood will be available at the park.
10. Toilet facilities will be set up at the center of the camp. Please ensure all campers use them.
11. Grey water must be dumped at the dumping station near the flag pole.
12. No alcoholic beverages allowed in camp. This is a **Scout Camp!**
13. Remember the Scout Camping Slogan: "Take Nothing but Pictures, Leave Nothing but your Thoughts."
14. A Scouters' meeting will be held on Friday eve. At 10:00pm in the headquarters building. This mandatory meeting will review the camp rules & the judging system. All groups **must** send at least one leader.
15. A 'Lost & Found' depot will be set up in the Headquarters (the stone building on the hill)
16. All fires must be off the ground in a container of some sort. Campfires must be a minimum of 2 meters (6') from all combustible material.
17. An artificial outdoor ice rink has been installed in the park. Everyone bring your skates! The rink is off limits to all groups from 10:00am to 4:30pm Saturday.
18. Harrison Park tobogganing hill is available depending on conditions. Use of the hill is the responsibility of the leaders of individual groups. Use at own risk.
19. Leaders should ensure their youth are properly equipped for winter camping.
20. Every group **must** supply volunteer(s) to help out with Saturdays events as available. Remember however, that one leader must be available to your youth at all times and one leader must be present in the campsite while the 'inspection' is being done.
21. Quiet time 11:00pm both nights.
22. There will be an OHL Hockey game this year between the Owen Sound Attack and Guelph. Tickets must be paid in full with the registration- **no refunds**. The game will start at 7:30pm at the Lumley-Bayshore Community Centre. There will be a bus available to shuttle to the game and back for \$2 per person. Please advise on your registration if you would be interested in the bus and how many tickets you would require.
